Conference Aims

- To provide a venue for the conduct of the biennial business meeting of Australian ecclesias.

Fellowship

- The basis of fellowship for Brisbane 2026 is as agreed by Australian ecclesias, namely "the 1958 Unity Basis as expressed in pages 13 15 of the Unity Book"
- The Conference Committee will refer matters relating to the fellowship standing of an individual wishing to attend the Conference to the sponsoring and home Ecclesias for resolution.

Activities

- All activity arrangements will be approved by the Conference Committee.
- Brothers may be invited to present, offer public prayer and read aloud from Scripture to any audience.
- Sisters may be invited to present expositional material, offer public prayer and read aloud from Scripture to audiences of sisters, women and children.
- Sisters may be invited to present non-expositional material to any audience.

- Sisters are asked to wear a head covering at the Memorial Meeting; however, the Conference Committee recognises this is a matter of conscience.
