The five tables below each contain sets of six descriptors in columns. For each of the tables, score each of the four columns from 1 to 4, where 1 is the column that equates or resonates the most to you, then give a score of 2 to the column that is next most like you, and so on. Give a score of 4 to the column that is least like you. So, for each of the five 'Score' rows you should end up with the numbers 1,2,3 & 4 in various orders depending on your personality choices.

SAMPLE

Note that you look at all 6 traits in each of the columns and make your ranking score accordingly. This person believed the descriptors in column D best equated with his personality, followed by A, B then C (the least like you)
