The Conference Transformed App will have all the information you need at your fingertips including maps, directions and more. Download at Apple App Store or Android Play Store from June 1st.

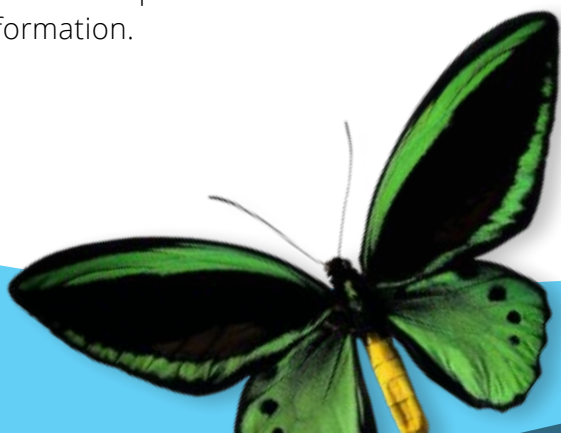
Children's Activities

Parking at Kelvin Grove SC

There is plenty of free car-parking spaces available on the Kelvin Grove Senior Campus and one in the Junior Campus ([view site map](#)).

Drivers are encouraged to drop-off passengers at the top car park just outside the College hall and proceed down the internal road and out to the other car parks.

Most parking spaces close to the hall have been reserved for those with mobility difficulties, service and delivery vehicles.

Registrants who have indicated they require priority parking spaces will be contacted regarding their allocated spaces.

An 11-seater **shuttle bus** will be doing a continuous circuit of the car parks (and the Quest Apartments) to ferry attendees up to the College hall. A timetable for this service is being compiled and will be sent out to attendees prior to Conference week.

Limited street parking is available but please check signs carefully for metered costs.
